

Response to the Requests for Clarification: Empowering Migrant Women Returnees through Economic Integration and Self-Sufficiency program

Proposal Submission Deadline: 10 April 2024

Possibility to apply as a consortium:

Proponents are allowed to either apply individually or as a consortium as indicated under 12.6. proponents may use the services of sub-contractors or sub-partners to partially perform the work. The proponent's Technical Proposal shall indicate clearly if the proponent is intending to use sub-contractors or sub-partners and their names. However, for management and accountability purpose it is advised that the consortium does not go beyond three organizations.

CSO eligibility:

Civil Society Organizations, be it National or International, legally registered and having operational presence in Ethiopia are eligible to apply for the call for proposal as indicated in the Terms of Reference "Legally constituted organization with a valid registration in Ethiopia with not less than ten years' experience".

Regional/Geographic focus:

As stated in the Terms of Reference geographic focus should be limited to two regions (Amhara and Oromia) and Addis Ababa City Administration focusing on localities which are migration prone, and with significant returnees.

Budget format:

Proponents are expected to follow the guideline and templet provided in the Call for Proposal. Proponents are required to include details as required in the budget templet.

Other clarification:

"Customer references" mentioned under the mandatory requirement/pre-qualification criteria refers to donors/funders/ development partners that the proponent has worked with as implementing partner or currently implementing with.
